 - Any agency that contributed specifically for that purpose and would like funds returned may notify LEPC

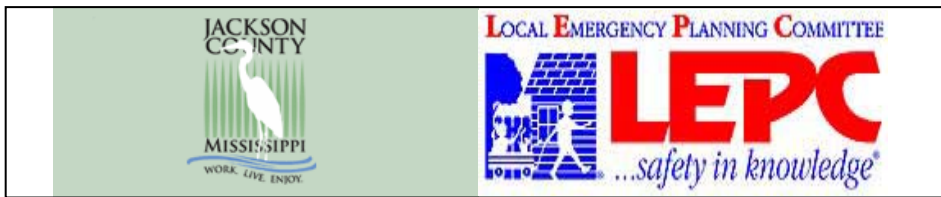
Site Incident Reports:

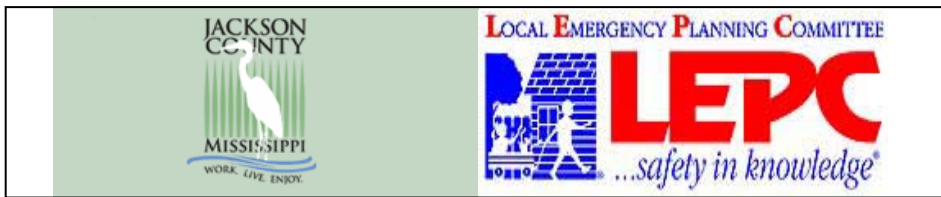

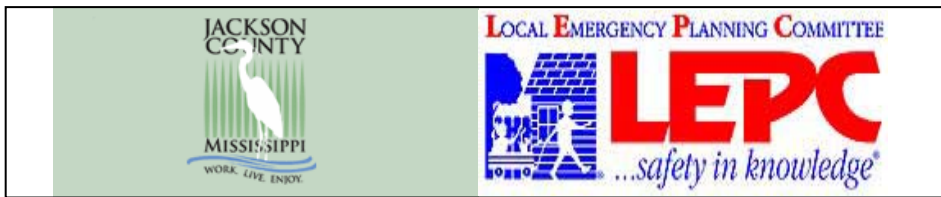
